This approach aims to help professionals and parents design effective educational environments for children and adults with developmental disabilities within school, community, and home settings. This system has guided the design and implementation in scores of classrooms for students with autism and related disabilities throughout the US and internationally. He is the co-founder of Pyramid Educational Consultants, Inc., an internationally based team of specialists from many fields working together to promote integration of the principles of applied behavior analysis within functional activities with an emphasis on developing functional communication skills independent of modality.

**Lori A. Frost, MS, CCC**, is co-founder of Pyramid Educational Consultants, with offices in the U.S., the U.K, Australia, France, Peru and Canada. She is a speech/language pathologist certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and has over 20 years experience working with children and adults with autism and related disabilities. The teacher reinforces the completion of all activities within the specified time and gradually reduces the time allowed until the student reaches the final goal!

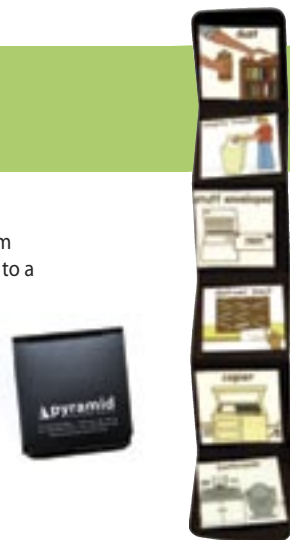

Instructors who use Differential Reinforcement Systems will find these CDs essential. Pop a CD into your CD player, select the track according to the interval you need, and repeat the track for a continuous reminder to catch your students "being good!" CD #1 has 1, 2, 3, and 5-minute intervals. CD #2 has 7 and 10-minute intervals. CD #3 has 15-minute intervals. Each track plays a distinct tone so that you can play more than one CD at a time for students needing different intervals and recognize which interval is sounding. Each tone is activated on a randomized, variable schedule (the three-minute tone sounds on average every three minutes). These tones also are a great tool for instructors who are teaching children to monitor their own behavior.

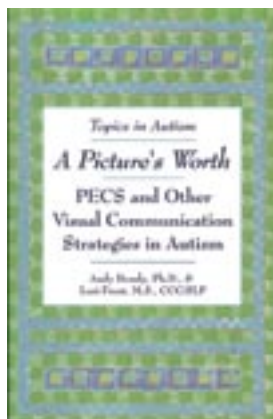

Written by our very own Andy Bondy and Lori Frost, this book examines the value of nonverbal communication strategies for children with autism, and describes the Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS). After a thorough review of verbal communication development, *A Picture's Worth* explains how autism affects the acquisition and progression of those skills. Without the ability to express themselves, children with autism experience a high level of frustration, which is the root cause of many undesirable behaviors. The book explores the relationship between behavior and communication, teaching parents how to recognize patterns in their own child's behavior and when to begin a visual communication program such as PECS. Bondy and Frost describe the six phases of training in PECS and provide many real-life case studies, along with a complete series of lessons, from beginner to more advanced PECS techniques.

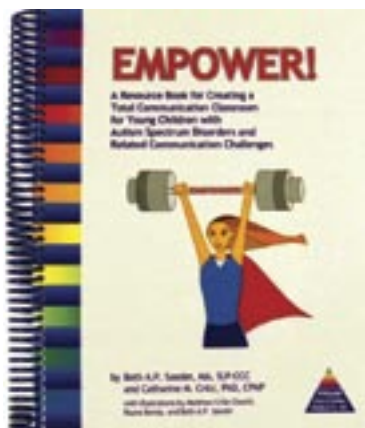

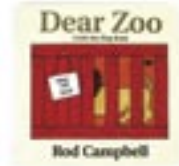
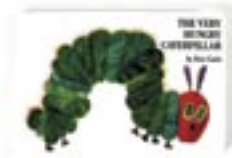
